PT will be conducted indoors, however still bring your APFT/PT jacket and pants. Uniform for opening formation on Saturday and Sunday is APFT/PT.

PACKING LIST FOR DRILL

Ensure you pay close attention to the Shippers Brief!



The Importance of checking your myPay

The reason you need to stay on top of your military pay is because it is YOUR money! Although most of the time nothing will be wrong, if you do not check your monthly LES (Leaves and Earnings Statement), you could be missing important information about your pay. Some examples that you should be aware of; a Soldier returned from training in August 2011 from Basic Training but was still paid Active Duty pay for an extra month that the Soldier WAS NOT on active duty. This means the Soldier was paid more than \$1,000 that they weren't entitled to. The military is going to take this money back from the Soldier, and the Soldier spent it all because they didn't check their LES. You will also be able to identify whether or not you are getting paid the correct rank and the correct SGLI is being taken from your pay. Once your myPay account has been set-up, print off your LES each month and bring it to drill. Your recruiter, SFC Burley, or Mr. Flaminio can look over it to ensure that everything is correct. Make sure you stay on top of YOUR pay!!
